Terms of Service and Privacy Policy

Section I – Terminology

The Administrator can refer to the Lead Administrator, the team of Administrators, or any group within Luke’s Intranet or another organization contracted by Luke’s Intranet granted administrative privileges of any kind, including content moderation, code development, site management, or any other privilege.

Section III – General Provisions

The legal jurisdiction of Luke’s Intranet headquarters and servers is DuPage County, Illinois. All ordinances, regulation, and laws of the County of DuPage, the State of Illinois, and the United States will be followed, no matter where the user is physically located.

Luke’s Intranet is a private, for-profit organization. Nothing stated here or on any service, app, publication, page, email, or any other form of communication necessarily represents (the view of) any other organization or individual, is endorsed by another organization or individual, or is related to any other individual or organization unless specifically noted.

It is the responsibility of the users to not post or use Luke’s Intranet services in an inappropriate manner. Luke’s Intranet is under no obligation to (unless required by applicable law) regulate the content generated by the users. This agreement is in no way an expression of commitment by Luke’s Intranet to moderate the platform (unless required by applicable law). The Administrator may attempt to regulate the platform, but it is ultimately the duty of the users to only use Luke’s Intranet services in acceptable ways and to report any potentially inappropriate content to Luke’s Intranet by contacting the Administrator or Support.

The statement “immediately” or “as soon as possible” should be read and interpreted in good faith; this includes the understanding that the individual may not notice the violation quickly, or at all. The phrase “immediately” or “as soon as possible” should be interpreted as meaning “immediately after seeing the violation” or “as soon as possible after seeing the violation.”

The user is assumed to be of legal age (eighteen in the United States). Users under the age of majority (eighteen in the United States) should not use any service from Luke's Intranet without prior parental/guardian approval. By continuing to use Luke's Intranet services, you agree that you are of legal age or have approval from a legal parent or guardian to use these services. You also agree that you or the parent or guardian (if applicable) has read and agreed to these terms, in which case both you and the parent or guardian (if applicable) are bound to these terms.

Luke's Intranet reserves the right to change these terms without any notice. Such changes may be in effect immediately.

Section IV – Legal Compliance

Any laws that apply only to the user based off their location or other factors will also be taken into account and should not be violated under any circumstances the user.

If any user breaks a law or ordinance of the County of DuPage, State of Illinois, or the United States of America, or any regulation active in the user's jurisdiction, they may face immediate punishment by the Administrator and may be referred to law enforcement. They may also be blocked from accessing Luke's Intranet services permanently.

If you suspect Luke's Intranet may be breaking any law in any way, please contact the Administrator immediately. Such activity is certainly not intentional and will be rectified as soon as possible.

Due to restrictive regulations in certain areas, features may be limited in some regions, or no services will be provided there at all. Luke's Intranet will comply with any and all applicable lawful orders issued by any legal authority in the United States. When issued by a foreign entity, Luke's Intranet may still attempt to do its best to follow the order and assist law enforcement. If the order requires Luke's Intranet to break laws or ordinances of the County of DuPage, State of Illinois, or the United States of America, the region will be blocked to ensure compliance with all legal entities. If such a case may potentially occur, please contact the Administrator as soon as possible to avoid any legal issues.

Some services may not be available to users currently located in the European Union for this reason.

Section V – Disagreement Resolution

Before engaging in arbitration or a lawsuit, you must officially inform Luke's Intranet within seven days of the incident. Before engaging in a lawsuit, arbitration must be attempted.

All disputes arising under these terms, or any agreements between the user and Luke's Intranet, shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois, County of DuPage, without regard to principles of conflict of laws. The parties to this agreement will submit all disputes arising under this agreement to arbitration in a location in the County of DuPage, Illinois

before a single arbitrator of the American Arbitration Association (“AAA”). The arbitrator shall be selected by application of the rules of the AAA, or by mutual agreement of the parties, except that such arbitrator shall be an attorney admitted to practice law in Illinois. Luke’s Intranet and you renounce the right to challenge the jurisdiction or venue provisions as provided in this section. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the party from obtaining an injunction. Agreements made in arbitration are final and not able to be appealed.

Section VI – Copyright Information

If you are a copyright-holder and suspect that any of your copyrighted material appears on Luke’s Intranet, please inform Luke’s Intranet by emailing ivanosky@lukesintranet.com and copying ivanosky@icloud.com. The content will be removed as soon as possible and only re-added after the content is proven to not illegally use copyrighted material or to break any license agreements. Removal of content is in no way an admission of guilt by Luke’s Intranet.

If the content is user-generated, its removal and prosecution will be governed under the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA).

Luke’s Intranet does not endorse or tolerate online piracy or theft in any way. All requests will be handled with urgency.

Section VII – Collection of Data

By using Luke’s Intranet services or by creating an account, you agree that:

1. Your data may be collected to improve Luke’s Intranet services
2. Advertisements may be present on Luke’s Intranet apps and services; advertisements and advertisers may or may not collect your data.
3. Some, none, or all of your data may be sent to, stored by, analyzed by, or sold to third parties in accordance with any and all applicable laws and regulations for purposes which may include but are not limited to:
 - a. Improvement of services
 - b. Analyzation of trends
 - c. Evaluation of compliance with these and other Terms and all applicable laws.

Section VIII – Licensing of Data

By using Luke’s Intranet services or by creating an account, you grant Luke’s Intranet a perpetual, transferable, royalty-free, and irrevocable license under the following terms:

1. Luke's Intranet has the explicit right to use your data to improve services, analyze traffic or trends, prevent service misuse, evaluate compliance with these and other Terms and all applicable laws, and distribute your data to third parties for the purposes outlined above.
2. You have the right to privacy of all data you create on apps if and where it is mentioned.
 - a. These apps and services may employ encryption techniques that prevent Luke's Intranet or affiliates from viewing your data without modification to the underlying code framework.
 - i. These methods may include using your password to encrypt files, asymmetric keys, and user-generated keys.
 - ii. Luke's Intranet may still be able to view this data if changes are made to the client-side code.
 - iii. This is not immunity from legal punishment or punishment by Luke's Intranet. Unlawful behavior or behavior that violates these terms will be punished in accordance with applicable laws.
3. When not mentioned, you waive the right of privacy to your data.
4. Luke's Intranet will always cooperate with requests made by users to remove data when required by law and will do its best to cooperate with requests made by users even when not required by law.

Section IX – Prohibited Uses and Activities

The use of Luke's Intranet services for any of the following purposes, in any case, is strictly prohibited:

- To conduct illegal or potentially illegal activity (including any references to illegal or potentially illegal content).
 - No matter where the activity was performed or where the server was physically located, United States law, and the law of the jurisdiction of the headquarters should always apply; these laws apply in addition to, not in lieu of, any laws where the user is located or server located. Those laws will apply when proper.
 - What is potentially illegal will be determined by the Administrator, law enforcement, or by users who choose to report the activity, in which case it will be reviewed by the Administrator.
- To make threats to (or actually) commit a crime, harass, bully, or discriminate against a user or break other policies.
- To distribute, create, promote, or control malware, ransomware, trojans, viruses, or any other software program designed to or used in practice to harm a computer, unless specifically authorized by an Administrator in writing. An Administrator will review each violation on a case-by-case basis. Pen-testing is prohibited unless prior written consent is given by any applicable users and Luke's Intranet. Attempts to breach security are also prohibited.

- To distribute, promote, or create spam or unwanted communications, unless specifically authorized by an Administrator in writing.
- To distribute, promote, or create content that is inappropriate for users under the age of eighteen or for users at large. This includes but is not limited to content relating to:
 - The promotion of drug, alcohol, or nicotine use or abuse, which includes but is not limited to:
 - Content including drugs, alcohol, or nicotine is allowed, if it does not promote the use thereof.
 - Solicitation of the drugs, alcohol, or nicotine to people is illegal strictly prohibited and may be referred to law enforcement if either user involved is suspected to be under the age of 21.
 - Promotion of the use of pharmaceutical drugs acquired through legal means may be allowed if and only if approved in advance in writing by the Administrator.
 - To distribute, promote, or create content containing sex or pornography, or references to sex or pornography
 - Including discussion of sexual activity in any way
 - Such cases may be referred to law enforcement if either user involved is suspected of being under the age of 18.
 - To use explicit language that is targeted at specific individuals or groups (slurs) of any variety, regardless of the intended audience or writer.
- To harass any user, individual, or entity.
- To discriminate against another person in any way, especially with regard to his or her race/ethnicity, religion/creed, sex/gender, or national origin. All claims will be evaluated by the Administrator, who reserves the right to make the final say, override, or extend any rules.
- Discrimination against groups of people is prohibited in the same way.

Section X – Potential Consequences

The Administrator will decide the punishment in all cases, which may include but is not limited to:

- Referral to law enforcement agencies
- Permanent or temporary banning of the user account, device, or IP address
- Disabling of certain service
- Entrance into Arbitration

The Administrator may decide another action taken by a user or other entity ought to be prohibited and will punish the user appropriately, even if the action and/or consequence is not specifically mentioned in the above list(s). Please exercise good judgment when using Luke's Intranet and do not

engage in any activity that could be deemed harmful, dangerous, or inappropriate. The Administrator will act in good faith when determining punishments.

The decision of the Administrator is a final decision, unless overruled by a higher-ranking executive at Luke's Intranet, neutral arbitrator, or court of law.

Under no circumstances is illegal activity endorsed by Luke's Intranet or permitted by Luke's Intranet. Report any potentially illegal activity or activity in violation of the Terms to the Administrator by filling out a form on the appropriate website or application or by emailing Luke's Intranet Support.

These prohibitions apply to all services. Services that employ techniques to enhance security and privacy of users and thereby prevent Luke's Intranet from reviewing activity or content distributed should in no cases be used to conduct illegal activity or otherwise break the terms of service. Please submit any evidence of usage of these services being used for nefarious purposes to Support or to the Administrator.
